Cemetery Rules and Regulations

In order to preserve the beauty of Mount Nebo Memorial Gardens and to respect those laid to rest here as well as their visitors, please be aware of and abide by the following policies.

Cemetery Visitation

- Mount Nebo Memorial Gardens is open to all visitors from 9 AM to 4 PM, Sunday through Friday. Visitors are not permitted outside these hours, on Saturdays, or on certain legal and Jewish religious holidays. Anyone entering the cemetery while Mount Nebo is closed to visitors will be considered a trespasser.
- No dogs or animals of any type are permitted in the cemetery except for guide dogs or other service animals.
- Alcohol and illegal drugs are not allowed on cemetery grounds.
- Mount Nebo is not responsible for theft or damage to any personal property, including items placed near burial spaces.

Decoration Policies

- No boxes, shells, toys, glassware, sprinkling cans, receptacles, or other items may be left within the cemetery, except for approved vases which meet the cemetery's specifications. Mount Nebo reserves the right to remove any such items and is not responsible to store or return them.
- All mausoleum decorations must be placed in permanent vases. Decorations may not be placed on the floor or on freestanding easels or wrought iron stands, nor may they be attached directly to the crypt by wire, tape, glue, or any other method.
- Mount Nebo may remove any natural or artificial flowers or plants as soon as they become wilted or unsightly. Flowers may also be removed during specified cemetery cleanings. Check our announcement page for information about any upcoming cleanups.
- No trees, shrubs, or other plants may be planted without express written permission from the cemetery. If such planting is allowed, Mount Nebo reserves the right to maintain or remove the plant if its appearance becomes unseemly.

Burial Requirements

- Before burial, Mount Nebo will provide forms that must be signed by both the owner of the interment rights for the burial space and the authorizing agent of the deceased. If these forms have been signed before a notary public, they may be faxed to Mount Nebo. If these forms have not been notarized, proof of identification such as a driver's license will be required from both parties.
- Mount Nebo relies on the identification of the deceased provided by the next-of-kin or an authorized representative. They have no obligation to verify that identity.
- All ground burials in Mount Nebo require an outer burial container that meets the cemetery's specifications. These specifications are available in the cemetery office.
- Mount Nebo has specifications for outer burial containers, memorials, and foundations. Written approval must be secured from the cemetery before any such structure is placed in Mount Nebo Memorial Gardens. Mount Nebo also reserves the right to specify the date and time of installation of these structures.
- If a burial container, memorial, or foundation is constructed in the cemetery without authorization, Mount Nebo has the right to remove the structure at the owner's expense.
- No memorial or foundation may be placed or removed from Mount Nebo Memorial Garden without written permission from both the owner of the interment rights and the deceased's next-of-kin, except if necessary for routine maintenance or landscaping. Mount Nebo reserves the right to move memorials without prior authorization if necessary for interment, repair, or upkeep.
- Mount Nebo offers no warranty on the work of third parties unaffiliated with the cemetery, such as memorial manufacturers and installers.

Transfer of Interment Rights

- If someone wishes to sell or transfer previously purchased interment rights to another individual, this must first be approved in writing by a representative of Mount Nebo Memorial Gardens.
- All transfers of ownership will be subject to a transfer fee. Transfers are not effective until the transfer fee has been paid to Mount Nebo.
- Interment rights may only be purchased for personal or family interment of the individual(s) designated at time of purchase. You may not purchase interment rights with the intention to resell them at a profit. Mount Nebo retains the right to refuse the transfer of any interment right or burial space if they determine the purpose is investment or speculation.
